HALONG BAY

The best panorama over Halong Bay comes from a blockbuster movie launched in 2016 - Kong: Skull island. Nowhere else on earth, even the volcano islands, are comparable with the expanse and distinctiveness of this Bay, where you can get shocked from the first sightseeing uncountable scattered rocky islets, wind and wave-eroded grottoes stretching over 1,500sq km. With close distance to Hanoi and international airports, sea connection with wellreserved islands nearby, Halong enables from popular fun water activities to more adrenalin sports like rock climbing, and recently it has also become an epicenter of ecotours and responsible travels.

NORTHERN MOUNTAINS

With four mountain ranges in crescent shapes, the North of Vietnam is a paramount mountain zone. Though each mountain range or area matches particular travel needs, they all offer craggy terrain, magnificent karst landscape, challenging roads and rich ethnology culture. Due to the high ground, the traditional residents here are mainly the minority-ethnic groups, who are maintaining distinctive cultural habits, inclusive of making colorful, delicate embroidered clothes by hand, building odd-shaped houses with thick walls for cold winter, challenging rocky fences, and organizing top exciting markets. During the last few years, more border gates with China and Laos have been opened for tourists with much easier procedures, making the Northern mountain a center of off-the-beaten-track tours with undiscovered attractions. Amongst hundreds of good points to discover here, the Threeland team recommend trekking and cycling in Pu Luong National Reserve, long journeys into Ha Giang, Bac Ha, where professional adventure services as well as fairly good road conditions are available to travelers.

DANANG, HOIAN MYSON SANCTUARY & HUE



The cluster of Danang and its surroundings is growing gloriously with new direct international flights, a deep seaport for cruiserships, good travel infrastructure and hi-qualified services. Amongst these, **DANANG** has been known widely for My Khe and Non Nuoc beaches, stretching over dozens of kilometers with crystal water, long sand dunes and deluxe resorts with spa centers. Danang now is a symbol of the peaceful Vietnam with granting sunshine holiday. Half-hour driving to the South from Danang, **HOIAN** is known as a boutique but lively township. Being a mixture of up-to-17th-century seaport with the harmony of ancient Japanese, Chinese and Vietnamese housing styles, Hoian reminisces the glory of a former trading hub, which now turns into a big cultural rendezvous. Recently, it is famous with An Bang plage, two new attractions at Tra Que vegetable villages and a silkworm

feeding center. Not far from Danang and Hoian, **MYSON** is considered as a sanctuary of Cham people, with strong Hindu influence in art and sculpture. The knowhow of making Cham Hindu towers at Myson and the South, though, is still a mystery. A discovery to this mysterious place will be also enriched by a charming Cham Dance at the sactuary, and a visit at the great Cham Museum in Danang.

Known as the royal capital in 19th century, **HUE, 100km from Danang**, also worths a visit for its reflection the old time's delicacy and conservation, with the last feufal dynasty's vestiges, archeological traces and a poetic, slow-paced rhythm. Hue is still different with tranquil ambience that requires more time to intermingle with the city's elegant people, to taste local dishes, or to contemplate royal trace décor and visit royal ornaments.

SAIGON (HOCHIMINH CITY - HCMC)



Saigon is the largest metropolis of Indochina, a harmony of French buildings and churches, shadowy streets, enthralling local-styled markets and modern skyscrapers. More than any cities of Indochina, Saigon is a mixture of religions, from Buddhism, Catholicism, Protestant, Islam, Hindu to local religions "Cao Dai" and "Hoa Hao", so each quarter has distinctive colors. Connected with Cambodia, Thailand, Singapore, Malaysia and Indonesia by short air, river and landways, Saigon has quickly become the first place for innovation, creativeness and new tour experiments in Vietnam. The city is also becoming a good transit for the best beaches in Asia, including Con Dao and Phu Quoc islands or other places on the Southern coastline. During the last ten years, the trips connecting Saigon with East Cambodia has positioned it as a center of deluxe Mekong cruises, as well as a stopover for sea cruiserships.

Due to the flat topography, the best tours are still the "Mekong delta trips" to Vinh Long, Can Tho, Sa Dec, Tra Vinh, and especially Chau Doc, the border town, from where we can get in a deluxe river-cruise linking Vietnam and Cambodia, enjoying high-class services and relaxation on the Mekong.

Here you can easily spend several days either for business or holiday, visiting the country's greatest highlights, contemplating the tranquility before hanging out to observe the daily life at its bridges, markets, suburban villages, or just taking your children to an unusual Buddha's park. Young travelers can also recharge themselves at Vientiane after a long trip, then make new plans to go up north by land, air or riverway, reaching the Northern mountains and rivers all the way to Luang Prabang, or to go down to the Southern Laos, where more sunshine, natural wonders, highland's coffee, tea and challenges for adventures are waiting.

LUANG PRABANG

Every visitor in Laos will agree that this town is a must to see. Being one of the former ancient capitals of Laos, the town is an incredibly graceful with authentic Laos spirit, traditional old houses, French-styled villas adjacent to lavish ancient temples. This is also a river-cross area, where you can witness many boat races in high water time, visit gorgeous pagodas in the countryside, and wake up at five o'clock to see hundreds of Theravada Buddhist monks in their daily alms giving ritual. Many tourists love to spend several days here before off to visit the Asia Center of Elephants Feeding. From Luang Prabang, you can also go up-north to the mountainous area to meet the minority ethnic people near Luang Nam Tha, enjoy elephant ridings, trek around tranquil villages with green gardens or go further to the Golden Triangle, now is an opium-free zone but still under the famous name at the border gate of Laos, Thailand and Myanmar.

SOUTHERN LAOS

Being neglected much more than Luang Prabang and Vientiane because of the lack of connection with travel hubs, the South of Laos has been nearly forgotten for a long time, luckily, this unpopularity leaves the area native beauty with untouched rivers, fish source, shadowy plain highland, divine waterfalls and many hidden river isles. Recently, good straight tarred roads have made Southern Laos popular to young travelers, especially in its possibilities to connect with Cambodia to the far South and to accommodate grand caravan trip going thru all Vietnam, Laos, Cambodia and Thailand. The facilities of the South, indeed, are less standardized than those in the North but it's totally capable to develop now. Those looking for ecotours will also find Southern Laos a paradise, especially if you are lucky to meet an endangered Irrawaddy dolphin on the Mekong at a bend near the Cambodia border, or have long time enough to stay in one of "thousand isles" near the border.
